

Being Carbon Neutral

Know your numbers. You can't manage emissions if you don't measure them.

Flying creates carbon emissions. CO₂ comes from the combustion of jet fuel and you can track how many carbon emissions your flight activity generates. And you can offset it. Carbon offsets fund verified projects that reduce or avoid emissions somewhere else. You use them to balance out the burning of jet fuel into the atmosphere. That's what carbon neutral means-offsetting 100% of your carbon emissions.

- 1. Contact Eclair to sign up for Carbon Neutrality through 4AIR.
- 2. Eclair will report flight data to 4AIR. All crew/pax info is redacted to ensure privacy. 4AIR calculates flight data, then delivers a monthly emissions dashboard report showing CO₂ footprint. All billing is coordinated through Eclair.
- 3. Continue flying as scheduled.
